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In *National Federation of Independent Business v. Sebelius (NFIB)*, the Supreme Court held that the Affordable Care Act's (ACA) Medicaid expansion was unduly coercive on the states, and limited the federal government's enforcement authority if a state fails to implement the expansion. *NFIB* is raising a number of questions for Medicaid programs across the nation. NHeLP continues to analyze the decision and implications for Medicaid and health care for low-income individuals and families.
