As signaled in their notice of supplemental authority dated December 30, 2013, plaintiffs-appellants Association of American Physicians & Surgeons and Alliance for Natural Health USA (collectively, "Plaintiffs") applied to the Circuit Justice to enjoin the requirement that non-Medicare physicians register in the online Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System ("PECOS") in order to refer Medicare-eligible patients for Medicare-covered services (*e.g.*, bloodwork, x-rays, oxygen) by Medicare providers of those services. The application was filed and docketed on January 3, 2014, as *Ass'n of Am. Physicians & Surgeons, Inc. v. Sebelius*, No. 13A699 (U.S.).
